Must be flexible in working hours by working at least one evening a week and participating in weekend pager rotation.

All duties and requirements are essential job functions. All requirements are subject to possible modification to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

An independent, self-motivated and assertive individual with the ability to relate to children and youth from highly dysfunctional families. Must possess good problem-solving skills and be an effective communicator with the ability to make quality decisions in a crisis-oriented environment. Must have skills necessary to recognize children at risk of sexual abuse.
