JOB SUMMARY:

This paraprofessional position is responsible for assisting victims of domestic violence and maintaining a classroom setting following the Children's Services Therapeutic Childcare Curriculum and the Department of Children and Families criteria. It is also responsible for providing crisis intervention, case management and advocacy for victims of domestic violence. Employee will work indoors, outdoors and off-site.

WORK EXPERIENCE/EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

High School diploma or G.E.D. required. Child Development Associate Credential (CDA), college degree in relevant field and/or one-year experience working in early childhood education and/or with families at risk preferred. DCF 30 and 10-hour courses, CPR/First Aid certified, and Florida Food Handlers Card required. A valid driver's license and dependable transportation required. Vehicle insurance must be maintained. Must meet eligibility requirements for Hubbard House, Inc. vehicle insurance coverage. All applicants must pass a level-2 background screening.
