#### **Food Drives**

Hubbard House serves more than 5,000 annually and provides emergency shelter to over 120 women and children requiring three meals daily, plus snacks. Please help us keep the Hubbard House pantry stocked with your donations of non-perishable food items. Examples of food items needed are: Instant mashed potatoes, instant rice, Juice, canned fruit, canned vegetables, crackers, cereal/cereal bars, peanut butter, jelly, white sugar, condiments, etc.

#### Toy & Gift Collection Drives

Donate new, unwrapped gifts from our <u>Holiday Wish List</u> (see page 4) to be distributed to women and children. Hubbard House creates two special Holiday Stores within the shelter each year—a Mother's Store and a Children's Store. Moms can pick out toys and presents for their children, and children can select special items for their mothers. With this program, families have the opportunity to know the joy of giving and celebration, even during a time of transition in their lives.

For Santa and his helpers, we have prepared a "Holiday Gift Wish List" that offers suggested gift guidelines, based on age group. Hubbard House staff members are also available to talk with you about larger gifts, such as bicycles, ipads, etc. Please leave gifts unwrapped; donations of wrapping paper, tape and bows are appreciated.

December 20th is the last day to accept donations so that parents can plan for the Holiday.

Decorative paper napkins, plates, table coverings and centerpieces will bring holiday cheer to residents as they have Thanksgiving and Holiday meals in the shelter kitchen areas.
